There is a factual principle which is taught in Dharma that elaborates,


“Whenever evil prevails over good upsets the natural order, there comes the Divine Mother's Divine Intervention.”


So, embrace the bagless spirit, have a blast and make the most of the bagless adventure. It's all about creating unforgettable memories with friends and teachers.
