A Noun is the name of a person, place, animal or thing: as Geeta, Mumbai, Table etc.

There are different kinds of nouns:

- 1. <u>Proper Noun</u>: A proper Noun is the name of a particular person, place or thing: as Akbar, Rama, Delhi etc.
- 2. <u>Common Noun</u>: A common Noun is a name which is common to any and every person or thing of the same kind: as boy, pencil, park etc.
- 3. <u>Collective Noun</u>: A collective Noun denotes a number of persons or things grouped together as a whole: as crowd, flock, fleet, team etc.
- 4. <u>Material Noun</u>: A material Noun denotes the matter or substance of which things are made: as gold, silver, iron etc.
- 5. <u>Abstract Noun</u>: An abstract noun is the name of some quality, state or action: as cleverness, laughter, poverty etc.
- 6. <u>**Concrete Noun**</u>: A concrete noun is a noun which can be identified through one of the five senses (taste, touch, sight, hearing, smell).
