TOPIC- MEANING OF A SENTENCE

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE PARENTS:

A Sentence is a group of words that has a complete meaning. A Sentence must begin with a capital letter and end with a full stop.

Now look at these simple examples-

- I go.
- I go for a walk every morning.

The first example 'I go' does not make a complete sense, so it is not a sentence. The other sentence makes a complete sense, so it is a sentence.
