While on the Road-

Always walk on the footpath.



- Walk on the left side of the road.
- Always cross the road at the zebra crossing. If there is no zebra crossing, wait till the road is clear.
- Never play on the road. A running vehicle may hit you.
- Do not tease stray animals you find on the road.

In very big cities, you may find a pedestrian traffic light. In this case, cross the road when the light is green.

While travelling in a bus-

- Stand in a queue at the bus stop.
- Never lean out or put your hand out of the window of a moving bus.

Never get in or get off a moving bus.

At home-

- Do not touch electric switches and wires with wet hands.
- Do not play with sharp things like blade or knives.
- Do not play with fire.
