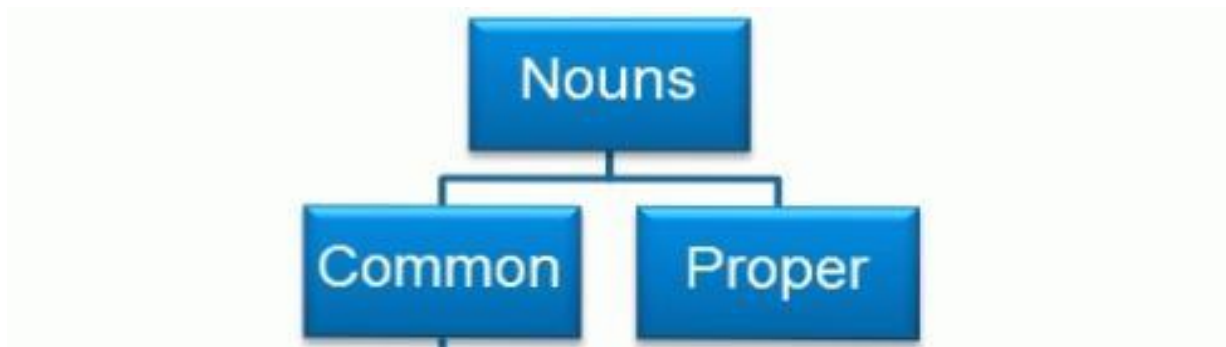
INSTRUCTIONS TO THE PARENTS:

Explanation:-

Kinds of Noun-: Common Noun and Proper

Noun.



1.Common Noun

A **common noun** is a common name of any person, place , animal or thing.

Example- boy , girl, city, village, dog, cow, chair, table , etc.

Some more examples:-

- car
- man
- bridge
- town
- water
- metal

2.Proper Noun

- A **proper noun** is a specific name of a particular person, place, animal or thing.
- A **proper noun** always begins with a capital letter, no matter where it falls in a sentence.

Example: Prayagraj (it refers to only one particular city), Steve (refers to a particular person), India (There is no other country named India; this name is fixed for only one country).

Some more examples:-

- Africa
- United Nations
- The Tower of London
- George
- The Red Fort
- December
- Wednesday

Some more examples of Common and Proper Noun

<u>Common noun</u>	<u>Proper noun</u>
man, boy	John
woman, girl	Mary
country, town	England, London
company	Ford, Sony
shop, restaurant	Spencer, Subway
month, day of the week	January, Sunday

Notes- *Proper Nouns always begin with a capital letter while Common Nouns will begin with a capital letter only when they are at the beginning of a sentence.*

For example- Boys love to play.

Here “Boys” is a common noun but it is at the beginning of the sentence. So, it will begin with a capital letter.
