

# Kinds of Noun-: Common Noun and Proper

# <u>Noun.</u>



## 1.<u>Common Noun</u>

A **common noun** is a common name of any person, place , animal or thing.

**Example-** boy , girl, city, village, dog, cow, chair, table , etc.

#### Some more examples:-

- car
- man
- bridge
- town
- water
- metal

# 2.Proper Noun

- A **proper noun** is a specific name of a particular person, place, animal or thing.
- A **proper noun** always begins with a capital letter, no matter where it falls in a sentence.

**Example:** Prayagraj (it refers to only one particular city), Steve (refers to a particular person), India (There is no other country named India; this name is fixed for only one country).

#### Some more examples:-

- Africa
- United Nations
- The Tower of London
- George
- The Red Fort
- December
- Wednesday

#### Some more examples of Common and Proper Noun

Common noun	Proper noun
man, boy	John
woman, girl	Mary
country, town	England, London
company	Ford, Sony
shop, restaurant	Spencer, Subway
month, day of the week	January, Sunday

<u>Notes-</u> Proper Nouns always begin with a capital letter while Common Nouns will begin with a capital letter only when they are at the beginning of a sentence.

## **For example-** Boys love to play.

Here "Boys" is a common noun but it is at the beginning of the sentence. So, it will begin with a capital letter.
