Instructions- Parents are requested to kindly help the child understand the meaning of punctuation and the punctuation marks.

Punctuation means the right use of stops and marks in writing. Some most important punctuation marks are:

- Full Stop- The full stop is used at the end of every sentence. It shows that the sentence ends with the last word.
 For example-
 - 1.) Obey your parents.
 - 2.) The school was closed in March.
- Capital Letter- A capital letter is used to begin a sentence or for a proper noun. It is also used to begin a new sentence after a full stop. For example-
 - 1.) Mr. Brown is a jockey.
 - 2.) I am fond of drinking milk.
 - 3.) Susan was ill. She had high fever.

Now see the picture below to understand the use of capital letters.



• Question mark- A question mark is used at the end of a sentence to ask a question.

For example-

- 1.) Would you like to have a cup of tea?
- 2.) What is your name?
- 3.) How old are you?
