LESSON- PRIMARY AND SECONDARY COLOURS

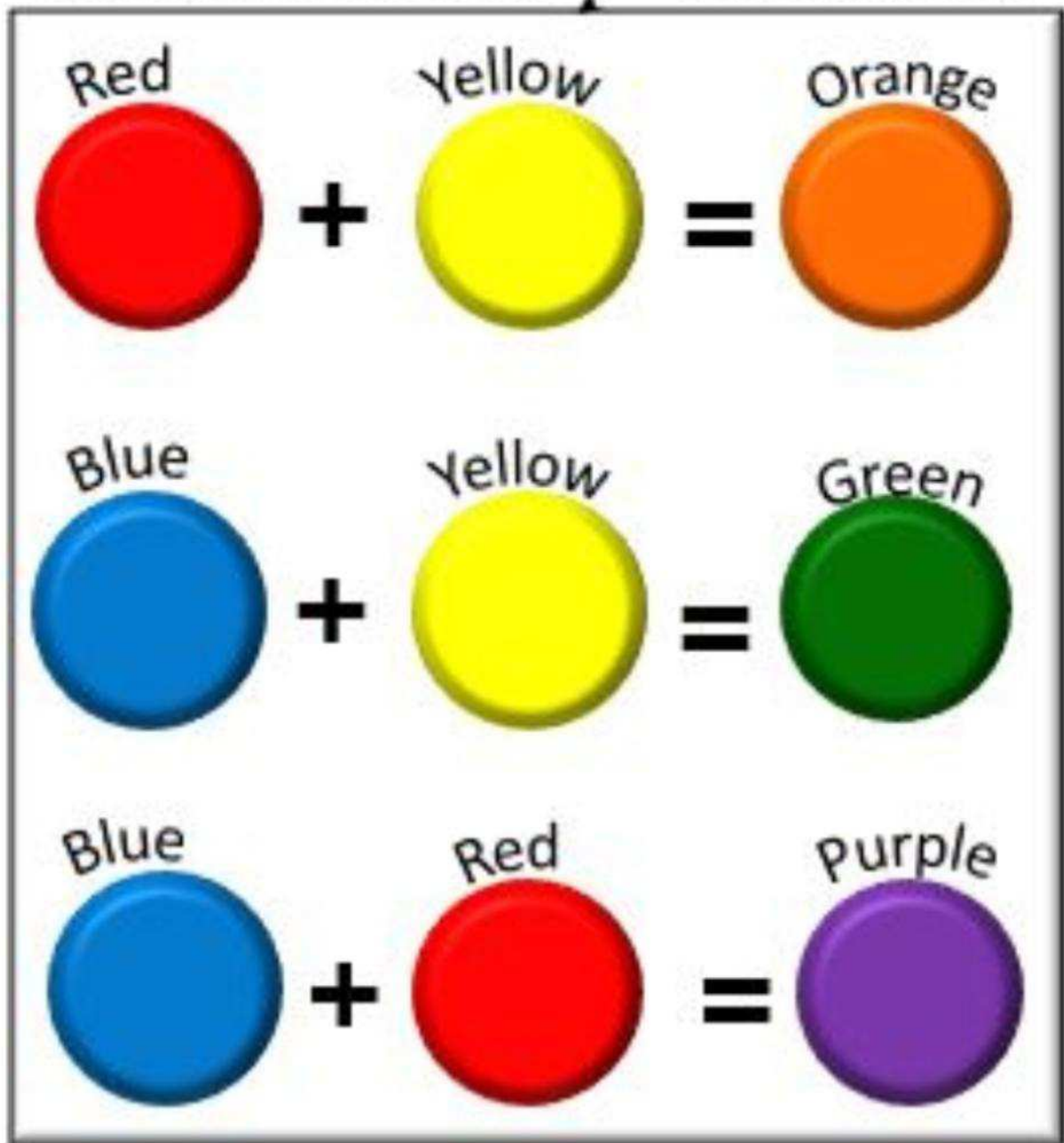
Look around you. The world around you is full of colours and to capture them in a painting, you need to know how colours are made.

PRIMARY COLOURS - Let's start from the most basic unit of colours : A Primary Colour is one that cannot be created by combining any other colours. You may look around and assume that there are dozen of Primary Colours, but in fact, there are only three. Other colours you see is created from a combination of these three colours. So what are they? The three Primary Colours are **BLUE, RED** and **YELLOW**.

SECONDARY COLOUR – A colour produced by mixing two primary colours in equal proportion are Secondary Colours. They are **PURPLE ,GREEN** and **ORANGE**.
