CHAPTER - 1: REPRESENTATION OF GEOGRAPHICAL FEATURES.

TOPIC: GLOBE AND MAP

A Globe is a man made model of the Earth. Since earth is round this helps us to see the shape, size and position of countries etc. It is used to locate places, see sea routes and air routes too. It helps children to understand where they live and where are the other places in the world located. The big areas made in blue represents water and are called oceans. Globe can be called as a duplicate of the earth. It shows accurate areas, distances, directions and relative shapes and size too.

A drawing or a plan of the surface of the earth that shows countries, rivers, mountains, road etc. is known as a map. Maps are useful for tourists and travelers as they can help them to reach their destinations. In a map we can include a title, scale, directions, grid, conventional signs and symbols and colours to show information. There are mainly three types of maps. They are Political maps, Physical maps and Thematic (Topographic) maps. We use symbols on maps. Symbols are used in maps to represent or indicate real objects or the characteristics. A collection of different types of maps bound together in the form of a book is called an Atlas.
