## Teachings of Jesus Christ

Jesus was a great healer. Legends say that he restored the sight of the blind and healed the sick. His simple lifestyle and the love and compassion he had for people earned him a lot of followers. Jesus rejected meaningless rituals. He asked his followers to give up their old sinful ways, devote their lives to God, and help other people. He condemned hypocrisy and greed.



The Sermon on the Mount is the most famous sermon delivered by Jesus. In it, he said

- \* love your enemies
- \* do not judge others.

- \* have faith in God
- \* give to the needy
- \* do unto others as you would have others do unto you.

A small group of disciples believed Jesus to be the most promised messiah who would bring an end to Roman rule. Meanwhile, the growing influence of Jesus alarmed many Jewish priests. They felt threatened by Jesus.
