KINDS OF SENTENCES:

There are four kinds of sentences -

1. **Declarative Sentence** -A declarative sentence is a statement. It provides information about something or someone. It ends with a full stop. For example,
 - The ground is slippery.
 - Children are happy all the time.
2. **Interrogative Sentence** -An interrogative sentence asks a question. It ends with a question mark. For example,
 - Am I very late?
 - Did you eat lunch?
3. **Imperative Sentence** - An imperative sentence gives an order or makes a request. It ends with a full stop. For example,
 - Please leave your footwear outside.
 - Be careful.
