Quick recap:-

- India is located in Asia. It is surrounded by the Himalayas and three large water bodies.
- Pakistan, Afghanistan, China, Nepal, Bhutan, Myanmar, Bangladesh and Maldives, Sri Lanka are our neighbours.
- There are 29 states and 7 Union Territories.
- India can be divided into five physical divisions:- The Northern Mountains, The Northern and Coastal Plains, The Western Desert, The Southern Plateaus and The Islands.
- The boundary between India and Pakistan is called the Radcliffe Line.
- Srinagar is the summer capital and Jammu is the winter capital.
- Chandigarh is a Union Territory and capital of two states.

EXERCISE 1: Write and learn the capitals of the following Union Territories:-


1. Andaman and Nicobar Islands

EXERCISE 2: Answer the following questions:-

1. Which state has two capitals? Write the names of the capitals.
2. Name the group of islands in the Bay of Bengal.
3. Name the group of islands in the Arabian Sea.
4. How many states and Union Territories are there in India?

EXERCISE 3: Map work:- Mark and label the seven Union Territories on the map of India. (Refer to the map given in the previous worksheet)

EXERCISE 4: Map work:- Mark and label the five physical divisions of our country on a physical map of India. (Refer to the map given below.) [Use pencil colour for colouring and black ball pen for labelling]



EXERCISE 5: Write and learn the following Questions and Answers:

Q1.) Why does the capital of Jammu and Kashmir shift from Srinagar to Jammu in winter?

A1.) Srinagar is the summer capital and Jammu is the winter capital because during winters, the temperature in Srinagar falls below the freezing point and it becomes very difficult to work properly. Thus, every year the capital is shifted to Jammu as it is not that cold in Jammu during winters.
