**Reference to the context:**

**Read the lines carefully and then answer the questions that follow-**

Unknown to them ,Ulysses and his men were hiding inside the wooden horse.

**Q1.**Who are referred to as 'them' here ?

**A1.** The people of Troy are referred to as 'them' here.

**Q2.** Why were Ulysses and his men hiding inside the wooden horse?

**A2.** Ulysses and his men were not able to enter the city of Troy as it was protected by huge walls , so they hid inside the wooden horse . The Trojans themselves wheeled the wooden horse into the city.

**Short Questions and Answers:**

**A1.** The Greeks entered the city of Troy and took away all the treasure and set fire to the buildings.

**Q2.** What big problem did the Greeks face?

**A2.** The big problem that the Greeks faced during the war was that they could not enter the city of Troy because it was protected by huge walls.

### **Long Questions and Answers:**

**Q1.** Why did the Greeks have to come to Troy to rescue Helen?

**A1.** The Greeks had to come to Troy to rescue Helen because the prince of Troy, Paris had kidnapped the Greek princess Helen . The Greeks set sail to rescue the lovely Helen.

**Q2.** Who was hiding inside the wooden horse and what did they do?

**A2.** Ulysses and his men were hiding inside the wooden horse. When everyone was sleeping ,after the merry-making , Ulysses and his brave men climbed down a rope ladder. They crept to the huge city gates and opened them. The Greek soldiers who were waiting outside entered the city of Troy.
