LESSON -SAFETY RULES

Instructions to the parents: Parents are requested to help the child in revising the lesson 'Safety Rules' given in worksheet no. 1 and 2.

Explanatory Exercises: The child should read, understand and learn the answers given below:

Exercise 1-Answer in Detail:

Q1) Which safety rules you should follow at home?

Ans. At home, we should

- Not play with fire.
- Not touch electric wires and switches with wet hands.
- Not play with knives and blades.

Q2) Do you follow safety rules at school? If yes, write two safety rules that you follow.

Ans. Yes, I follow safety rules at school.

The two safety rules that I follow at school are-

- I never run up or down the stairs.
- I never jump on the benches.

Q3) How should we cross the road?

Ans. When we cross the road, we should always-

- Stop on the footpath.
- Look both ways- right, then left, then right again.
- Then cross the road.

Q4) Write any three safety rules that you should follow while learning to swim?

Ans. While learning to swim, we should -

- Never go alone for a swim.
- Always use a swimming tube.
- Always take a bath after a swim.

Q5) Write two rules that we should follow while travelling in a bus.

Ans. While travelling in a bus, we should-

- Stand in a queue at the bus stop.
- Never put our hand out of the window of a moving bus.
