Let us look at some of the amazing animal superlatives-

Largest Animal-

The <u>Blue Whale</u> is considered to be the largest animal. The average adult size of it is 80 feet long and weighs around 120 tons.



• Smallest Animal-

The <u>Bumblebee Bat</u> measures between 30 to 40 millimeters long. It also weighs only two grams.



Fastest Bird-

The <u>Peregrine Falcon</u> can dive to a speed that can exceed 200 miles per hour. It does so when it dives for prey while in mid air.



• Slowest Animal-

The <u>Three-Toed Sloth's</u> top speed is a staggering 0.003 miles per hour. It's so slow that algae grow on it.



• Tallest Animal-

The <u>Giraffe</u> can reach a height that ranges from 16 to 20 feet.



Animal with the Most Powerful Bite-

The <u>Saltwater Crocodile</u> has a bite force that measures a bone-crushing 3,700 pounds per square inch.



• Largest Bird-

The <u>Ostrich</u> can grow to a height of nine feet and can weigh up to 350 pounds. It also lays the largest eggs of any bird, which can weigh up to three pounds.



• Fastest Running Animal-

The <u>Cheetah</u>(Leopard) can sprint to a top speed of 70 mph when catching prey. That's as fast as most highway speed limits.



• Longest living land Animal-

<u>Turtles and Tortoises</u> have a long, healthy living and are the longest living land animals. The life span of an average turtle is 80 years.

The skin of a yam is thick and rough like the bark of a tree. Yams are a bit like potatoes.




Z- Zucchini
