Let us look at some of the amazing animal superlatives-

- Largest Animal-

The Blue Whale is considered to be the largest animal. The average adult size of it is 80 feet long and weighs around 120 tons.



- Smallest Animal-

The Bumblebee Bat measures between 30 to 40 millimeters long. It also weighs only two grams.



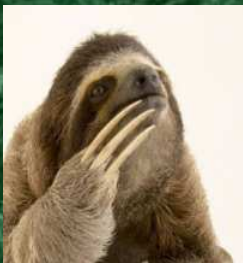
- Fastest Bird-

The Peregrine Falcon can dive to a speed that can exceed 200 miles per hour. It does so when it dives for prey while in mid air.



- Slowest Animal-

The Three-Toed Sloth's top speed is a staggering 0.003 miles per hour. It's so slow that algae grow on it.



- Tallest Animal-

The Giraffe can reach a height that ranges from 16 to 20 feet.



- Animal with the Most Powerful Bite-

The Saltwater Crocodile has a bite force that measures a bone-crushing 3,700 pounds per square inch.



- Largest Bird-

The Ostrich can grow to a height of nine feet and can weigh up to 350 pounds. It also lays the largest eggs of any bird, which can weigh up to three pounds.



- Fastest Running Animal-

The Cheetah(Leopard) can sprint to a top speed of 70 mph when catching prey. That's as fast as most highway speed limits.



- Longest living land Animal-

Turtles and Tortoises have a long, healthy living and are the longest living land animals. The life span of an average turtle is 80 years.
