**3. Justice-** The symbol of Justice is the statue of a blindfolded woman holding a sword in one hand and scales in the other .



**4. World Wildlife Fund**- The World Wildlife Fund is an international non-governmental organization, working in the field of wilderness preservation.



**5. Recycle**- To collect and treat used objects and materials that are ready to be thrown out in order to produce materials that can be used again.



**6. Red Cross**- The Red Cross is an international organization that helps people who are suffering, for example as a result of war, floods, or disease.



**7. Help Age**- Help Age is an Indian organization focused on the concerns of elders. Its mission is to work for the cause and care of the disadvantaged older persons and to improve their quality of life.



**8. Peace-** A situation or a period of time in which there is no war or violence in a country or area.



**9. Medical-** It is a Doctor's symbol. It is a staff or rod with a snake curled around it.



**10. Eco- Friendly-** Eco- Friendly means the processes which are not harmful to the environment and are environment friendly.
