Explanatory Exercises

Exercise - Answer in Short:

Q1) Why does life exist on Earth?

Ans. Life exists on Earth because it has air, water and the right temperature.

Q2) Why is the Earth called the Blue Planet?

Ans. The Earth is called the Blue Planet because about three-fourth of the Earth is covered by water and when seen from the space it looks blue in colour.

Exercise - Answer in Detail:

Q1) How did Ferdinand Magellan prove that the Earth is round?

Ans. About 500 years ago, Ferdinand Magellan and his crew started from Spain on a long sea journey. They kept sailing in one direction. After nearly three years, they reached the same place from where they had started. This proved that the Earth is round .

Q2) What is a map? How is it more useful than a globe?

Ans. A map is a drawing of the Earth or a part of it on a flat surface.

A map is more useful than a globe because-

- It is not possible to show all the places on a small globe.
- It will be difficult to carry a huge globe whereas maps can be carried easily from one place to another.
