
LESSON- 3D Effect


3D-3D (or 3-D) means three-dimensional, or having three **dimensions**. For example, a box is three-dimensional; it is **solid**, and not **thin** like a piece of **paper**. It has **volume**, a top and bottom, left and right (**sides**), as well as a front and back. You can turn the box around to view it from another side (called a **face**, **surface** or simply **side**). *An example of 3D is a movie in which you are given special glasses to watch.*

The three dimensions are often called **length** (or depth), **width** (or breadth), and **height**. Some purposes use other words.




2D Shapes
