# NATIONAL FESTIVALS OF INDIA

Republic Day, Independence Day and Gandhi Jayanti are the three national festivals that we celebrate.

<u>Republic Day</u> - We celebrate Republic Day on 26<sup>th</sup> January. The President hoists the national flag at Rajpath, New Delhi. This is followed by a grand parade. The armed forces, police, folk dancers and school children take part in the parade.

<u>Independence Day</u> - We celebrate Independence Day on 15<sup>th</sup> August. India became independent on this day in 1947. The Prime Minister hoists the national flag at the Red Fort in Delhi.

<u>Gandhi Jayanti</u> - We celebrate Gandhi Jayanti on 2<sup>nd</sup> October. It is the birthday of Mahatma Gandhi. A prayer meeting is held at Raj Ghat, the Samadhi of Mahatma Gandhi.
