


Steps for thumb painting :-


- 1. Fill your water cup with water . Dip the brush in the water and mix it in your chosen colour in the paint box until you have lots of paint on the brush . Now , paint your thumb.
- 2. Press your thumb coated with paint firmly on the drawing sheet to create a colourful thumbprint.
- 3.Let it dry properly.
- 4.Now , with the help of a pencil you can outline and draw the objects .

Topic 6 : Underwater Life

Underwater is the life below the surface of water. Marine life or sea life or ocean life include the plants, animals and other organisms under the surface of water.

Steps to paint underwater life :-

- 1. Paint the underwater background with blue watercolour.
- 2. With a flat brush make some waves.
- 3. Wait for the background to dry completely and then draw the fish , plants , octopus , etc.

(<u>Instruction</u> - The child must draw and paint any one of the following.)
