In 1961, many influential and wealthy people started the World Wildlife Fund for Nature (WWF). It is an International Non-Governmental Organisation that works with conservation, research and restoration of the environment.

It is working to stop further damage of Earth and to build a future in which humans can live in harmony with Nature. WWF concentrates on forests, freshwater ecosystems, oceans and coastlines. It also supports work involving endangered species of animal and plant life, pollution and climate change. The "logo" or symbol of WWF is a picture of Chi Chi, the Giant Panda- the famous black and white bear from China that is an endangered animal.

While the concern of WWF is the environment and endangered wild animals globally, there are other smaller organisations that take care of domestic animals in distress in towns and cities. They provide shelter, food and medical care for lost or abandoned pets and are funded by well-wishers and animal lovers. For children who are interested in animals and Nature, there are many interesting programmes to view on television.
