ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROJECT

INSTRUCTIONS:

- The students need to fill the Index Page. (S.No.; Topic; No. of pages used e.g. 1 to 4)
- The notebook should be covered properly with a coloured paper and name slip to be pasted on it.
- Details such as Name; Class; Roll No.; Adm. No.; Subject and Subject Teacher's Name to be written on the 1st lined page of the project assignment notebook.

TOPIC – OPPOSITES

- On the ruled side (lined side) Write the opposites of the given words: stand, front, happy, light, soft, fat, boy, rich, young, narrow.
- On the plain side: Paste the pictures of the given words and their opposites.
- One word and its opposite to be written on 1 page(ruled side).
- On the plain side, only one word and its opposite picture should be pasted(i.e. two pictures only).
- Label the pictures.
- Total 10 lined pages and 10 plain pages to be used.
